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# Napkin Ring made with Pretty Pines Thinlits



### Supplies for Napkin Ring:

- ♥ **Cardstock / Paper:** Early Espresso (119686), Mossy Meadow (133676), Gold Foil Sheets (132622)
- ♥ **Tools / Misc:** Pretty Pines Thinlits Dies (141851), Big Shot (143263), Magnetic Platform (130658), Big Shot Die Brush (144262), Pinewood Planks 3D Dynamic Textured Impressions Embossing Folder (143708), 1/4" Copper Trim (144179), Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

### Measurements for Napkin Ring:

- ♥ **Early Espresso Cardstock:** 1 x 6 for ring
- ♥ **Mossy Meadow Cardstock:** 3 x 4 for pine boughs
- ♥ **Gold Foil:** 1-1/4 x 2-1/2 for pine cone
- ♥ **Copper Trim:** 5"

### Instructions for Napkin Ring:

1. Run Early Espresso cardstock through the Big Shot using Pinewood Planks 3D Dynamic Textured Impressions Embossing Folder to texture. Apply Tear & Tape adhesive to back of one end, peel off backing and wrap around napkin to create ring.
2. Cut pine boughs from Mossy Meadow cardstock using Pretty Pines Thinlit Dies, Big Shot and Magnetic platform. Use Big Shot Die Brush to remove pine boughs from dies if needed. Attach tops of pine boughs to napkin ring with two Mini Glue Dots each.
3. Cut pine cone from Gold Foil using Pretty Pines Thinlit Dies, Big Shot and Magnetic platform. Use Big Shot Die Brush to remove pine cone from dies if needed. Apply dimensionals to back and adhere over tops of pine boughs.
4. Tie single knot in center of Copper Trim, stretch each end of ribbon and shape as desired. Attach to top of pine cone with Mini Glue Dot.
