



Maximizing Cardstock for a Simple Fun Fold Zany Zebra Card



Supplies:

♥ **Stamp Set:** Zany Zebra (152536)

♥ **Ink:** Melon Mambo (147051)

♥ **Cardstock:** Melon Mambo (115320), Whisper White (100730)

♥ **Tools / Misc:** Stitched So Sweetly Dies (151690), Tasteful Labels Dies (152886), Old World 3D Folder (153200), Bone Folder (102300), Paper Snips (103579), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334), Stampin' Seal (152813), Clear Block Bundle (118491), Stamparatus (146276), Small Grid Paper (149621)

Measurements:

♥ **Melon Mambo Card Stock:** 4" x 5-1/4"

♥ **Whisper White:** 4-1/4" x 5-1/2", 3-1/8" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4", 2-1/2" x 3-5/8" & scrap for die image (outside sentiment)

Instructions:

1 - Center largest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die on 4" x 5-1/4" Melon Mambo Cardstock with smallest Stitched So Sweetly Rectangle Die placed in center of largest die. Run through Die Cutting Machine.

2 - Texture frame piece using Old World Embossing Folder, then adhere to 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" Whisper White Cardstock.

3 - Stamp zebra image on 2-1/2" x 3-5/8" Whisper White Cardstock, then adhere to largest Rectangle image.

4 - Stamp inside images inside folded 3-1/8" x 8-1/2" Whisper White Cardstock. Adhere rectangle (from step #3) to front, then adhere to card front.

5 - Stamp outside sentiment using Melon Mambo ink on banner image cut from Whisper White cardstock using Stamparatus (see video for instructions). Adhere banner to small scalloped rectangle, then adhere to card front.
