

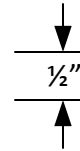
Cardstock Frame with Easel



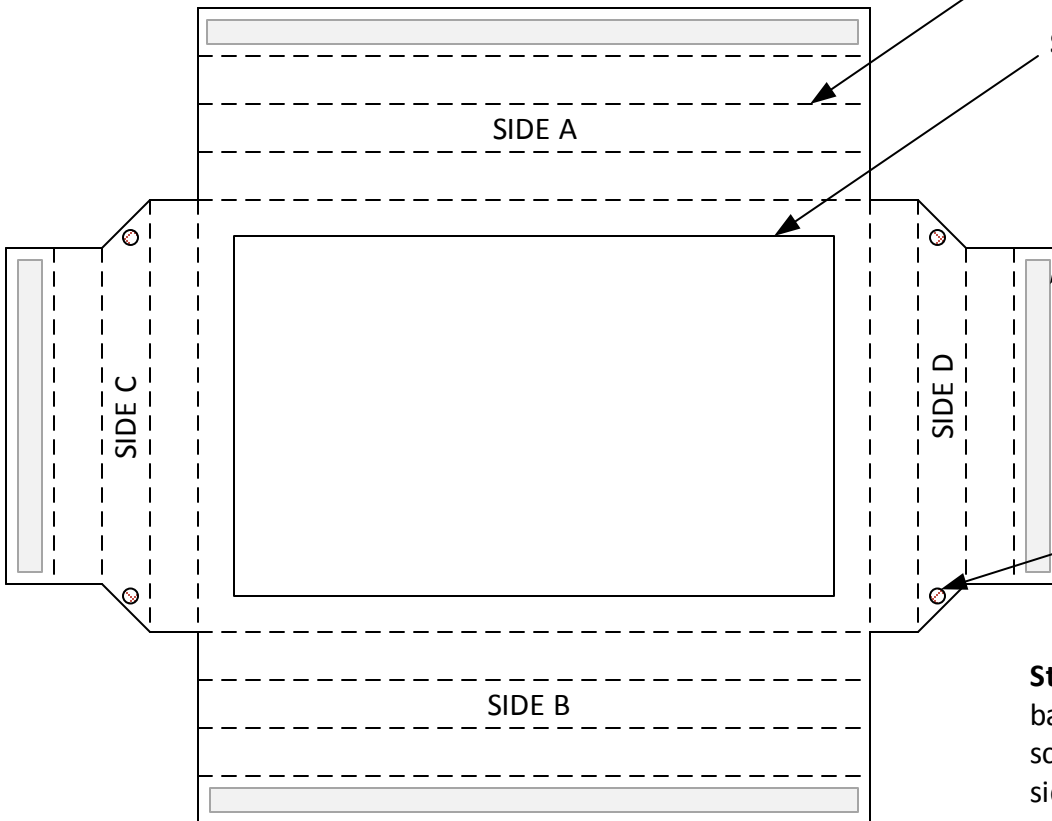
**Step #1** - Score 8-1/2" x 11" cardstock along each side at 1/2", 1", 1-1/2" & 2" (4 places)

**Step #2** - Cut corner sections out (4 places)

**Step #3** - Cut first two panels 1/2" from edge, cut 3<sup>rd</sup> panel on a diagonal to edge of cardstock (4 places as shown)

**Step #4** - Fold all score lines (valley folds)

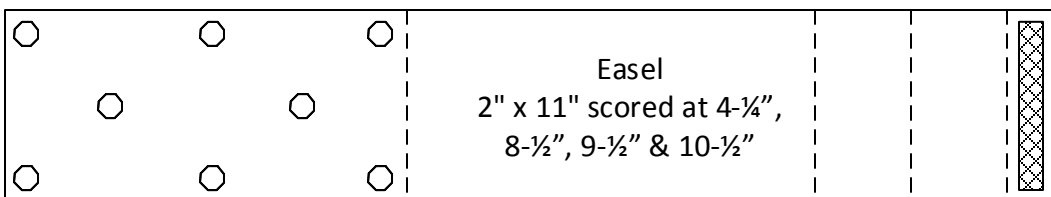
**Step #5** - Adhere 4" x 6-1/4" Designer Paper to center panel

**Step #6** - Add Tear & Tape on BACK/OTHER SIDE on end panels (4 places as shown)

**Step #7** - On 'SIDE A' remove backing from Tear & Tape the fold score lines to create tube-type side of frame. Repeat for 'SIDE B'.

**Step #8** - Adhere Mini Glue Dots to 'SIDE C' & 'SIDE D' (4 places as shown)

**Step #9** - On 'SIDE C' remove backing from Tear & Tape the fold score lines to create tube-type side of frame. Repeat for 'SIDE D'.



**Step #10** - Create Easel per dimensions shown. Attach to back of frame with Dimensionals
